


With effect from 17 Nov 2020, foreign patients from countries with Air Travel Pass (ATP) arrangements will no longer be required to apply for MOH waiver to seek medical treatment in Singapore.



Countries with special travel arrangements

Criteria for foreign patients to seek medical care in Singapore



Foreigners may apply for an ATP for entry into Singapore at no charge
<https://capels.caas.gov.sg/atp>



Applications must be made between 7 days prior to the visitor's intended date of entry into Singapore.



Have been in stated countries in the last 14 consecutive days before departing for Singapore



Travel to Singapore on a direct flight without transit



Visitors who require a visa must separately obtain a valid visa after receiving ATP approval

Pre-departure preparation for successful applicants

SG Arrival Card



Submit health, travel history, and accommodation declarations electronically via the SG Arrival Card e-Service (<https://eservices.ica.gov.sg/sgarrivalcard>), no earlier than 3 days prior to date of arrival in Singapore

TraceTogether App



Check mobile device's compatibility with TraceTogether, download the app, and register mobile number and personal details



COVID-19 PCR Test

Visitors should register and make payment on <https://safetravel.changiairport.com> for their on-arrival COVID-19 PCR test prior to departing for Singapore

On-arrival requirements and procedures



A valid ATP approval letter (electronic or physical copy) for the specified period of entry into Singapore

Valid visa (for visa-required visitors)



A mobile device with the TraceTogether app already downloaded and activated



Undergo a COVID-19 PCR test at the airport upon arrival in Singapore



Take private transport from the airport to the declared place of accommodation (non-residential) and remain isolated until test result confirmation. Patient can visit the hospital for medical consultation only after the entry swab test is negative

Retain the TraceTogether app with the data on mobile device for 14 consecutive days after leaving Singapore



Upload all data in the TraceTogether app upon request by MOH if tested positive for COVID-19 while in Singapore or in the 14 days after leaving Singapore
